(grandparent or older adult with grandchild ages 3 - 4)

10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. – July 5 - 7 (Wed. – Fri.)

One grandparent (or older adult) and one grandchild attend for a single fee.

Fee: \$75.00 (one fee for both grandparent and grandchild registration)

Expectations of Campers:

Campers should be able to:

- Stay with their assigned group with minimum reminders.
- Explore the natural world and move themselves along trails, over uneven ground, up and down hills, and across bridges and streams.
- Interact with their peers in group games and activities and maintain appropriate self-control in social situations.

Information & Policies

You can enjoy more than one Parks’ camp this summer!

Children in Grand! Camp that are ages 3 ½ and 4 can also enjoy Preschool Discovery Mornings and the 4 year olds can participate in preschool camps held at California Woods and Trailside Nature Center as well.

Who May Attend Grand! Camp: One grandparent (or older adult) and a grandchild ages 3 - 4. Activities are specifically chosen and tailored to have grandparents and grandchildren experiencing the natural world together. **If a child of the wrong age is registered for a camp, you will be notified by our main office and we will try to accommodate you in another camp but we can not provide a refund.**

Non-Refundable: Camp registrations are **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

Due to the popularity of our camps, **we will provide a wait list**. Please recheck weekly online for openings that may occur in previously sold out camps.

All transfers of registrations must be processed through our office at 321-6208; children will not be able to attend without prior approval and proper paperwork completed. Please only register for the camp your child can attend and which do not conflict with other summer plans you may have. Camp fees may not be prorated for any days of camp missed due to weather cancellations (see below for more information), homesickness, voluntary withdrawal, behavior challenges, illness or injury.

Confirmation: Confirmations are sent via email within minutes after registering online. Review for accuracy; contact us at 513-321-6208 if corrections are needed. Email reminders are sent the week before camp.

Preparing for Camp: Campers should dress to be outdoors, whatever the weather. Old clothes and sturdy tennis shoes or boots are essential. Participants should bring a bag lunch with drink and a water bottle to camp every day; refrigeration is not available.

Weather: Summer weather can be unpredictable. Outdoor activities will continue during a light rain and activities moved indoors during heavy rain or severe weather. During heat alerts, hiking and other lively activities occur earlier in the day and quieter activities after lunch.
